The Mayor's Community Improvement Program is for neighborhood beautification projects, such as planting trees, adding or enhancing the neighborhood entrance or adding an entrance marker or projects that involve enhanced public safety – such as speed bumps, signage or lighting. Up to \$1,000 will be awarded to winning neighborhood projects based on award criteria and innovative ideas. The neighborhood 50% match may be in the form of cash or volunteer participation.

The City of Mobile will purchase supplies, equipment or plant material as needed for each of the winning projects, which must be located on City of Mobile right-of-way.
